Trial Rules/Guidelines

A Terrier bred by the judge may not be shown under that judge in the conformation division. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division. Overly aggressive dogs, or the owners failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the judges or the trial chairperson.

- All BWTA racing classes are pre-entry only.
- All racing terriers must be muzzled to race.
- No refunds/substitutions except for bitches in season.
- Bitches in season not allowed on trial grounds.
- No loose dogs on the trial grounds.
- No puppies under 3 months allowed on the grounds.
- No puppies for sale on trial grounds.
- We reserve the right to deny any entry for any reason, entry fees will be refunded.

Any person violating these rules will be asked to leave and no refunds will be given—NO EXCEPTIONS

Directions

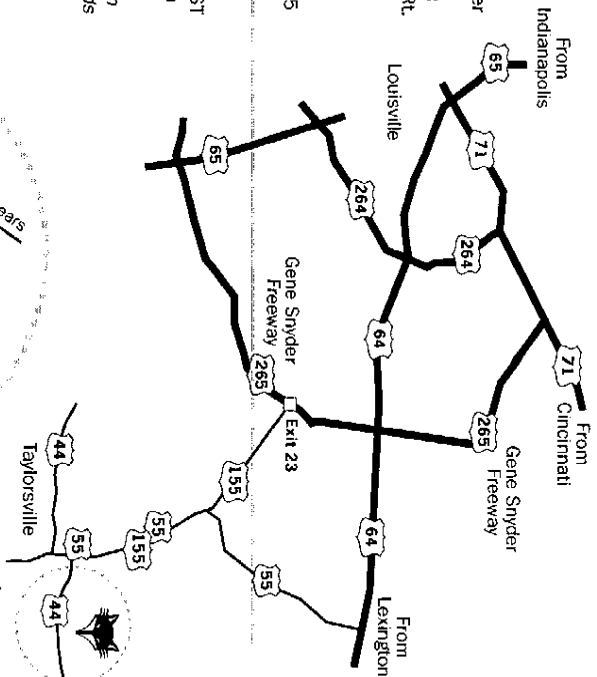
From I71 or I65:

Take the Gene Snyder Freeway (I-265) to Exit 23: Take Exit 23 (T'own/Taylorville/Rt. 155) & go EAST towards Taylorville. Go 1.6 miles & turn RIGHT at stoplight, continuing on Rt. 155 SOUTH/55 SOUTH Go 1.3 1/2 miles into Taylorville, & turn LEFT onto Rt. 44 EAST (stoplight/green sign for the Fairgrounds)

** Go 3 miles & turn LEFT onto Fairgrounds Road (green sign for Fairgrounds); The Fairgrounds are 0.8 miles on the LEFT.

From I64:

Take Exit 32 and go SOUTH on Rt. 55 (towards Taylorville) Go about 10 miles & turn LEFT to continue on Rt. 55 SOUTH Go 4.7 miles into Taylorville & turn LEFT onto Rt. 44 EAST (stoplight/green sign for the Fairgrounds) Follow above **

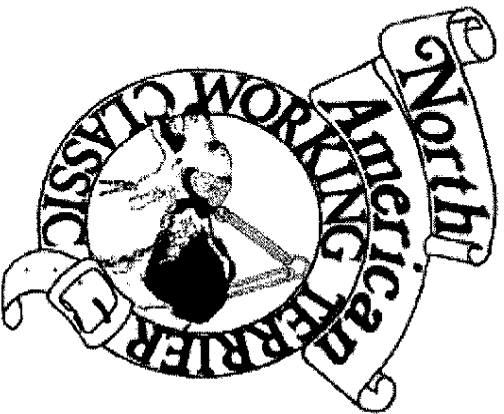

Featuring the 11th Annual BWTA High Point Versatility Award

The Bluegrass Working Terrier Association is honored to sponsor this award and very proud to promote the versatility of the working terrier and dachshund breeds. This award will go to the dog with the highest score in one of each performance divisions 1-7.

You may enter as many classes in each division as you like, but only the single highest placement you receive in each division will count towards the versatility award points. The more classes you enter the better chance you will have. Versatility placements in each class will be tallied separately and in addition to the regular class placements, for example, your versatility dog may be fourth in the class overall but have the first place score of the versatility entries in the class. The points are kept as follows: 1st place = 15 points, 2nd place = 10 points, 3rd place = 9 points, 4th place = 8 points, 5th place = 7 points, 6th place = 6 points. In the event of a tie a tie breaker will be necessary. The tie breaking competition event will be determined by the trial chair and the BWTA officers. The high point versatility award is pre entry only and is an extra one time \$5 entry fee per dog.

We are also pleased to offer the Wicca Weber Agility Award

This award is for the highest combined games score in Gamblers Choice, Jumpers and Tunnelers agility classes. No entry fee is required for this award. Kindly donated by Pat and Wicca Weber.

Division 1. BWTA Go To Ground

For any earthworking terrier or dachshund type, with the broadest possible interpretation ☺ if you call it a terrier we'll call it a terrier! BWTA time limits and other rules apply for each division. Both puppies and adults may completely progress from Novice to Championship at this trial. Dogs may move up from Novice to Open class by paying another entry fee. Progression from Open to Champion class is then without a fee.

We are proud to offer a perpetual trophy to the fastest overall time of the day in the 30 long foot tunnel, sponsored by Susanne Busse.

Go To Ground rules:

- Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted.
 - Score sheets for the exhibitor's dog is included in the entry packet to be picked up at the trial secretary desk, please take the score sheet to the GTG when you are ready to compete.
 - A line approximately two feet from the den entrance will be designated as the starting line. The dog is to be released so that all four feet are on the ground behind the starting line.
 - After the dog is released the handler will remain next to the entrance hole, commands and encouragement may be given. The judge will signal when the dog has completed working.
 - Dogs that have scored 100% in the Novice or Open class at any trial may not compete in these classes at this trial.
 - The steward may upon a rule violation disqualify an entry. All decisions of the judge are final!
 - For new competitors, the Novice is the short 10 foot tunnel with one turn, the Open and Champion is the 30 foot tunnel with two turns.
1. Pre-Novice Puppy GTG - Under 6 months of age
One minute to reach quarry, mark quarry for 15 seconds, may leave and reenter multiple time.
 2. Novice Puppy GTG – 6 – 12 months of age
Open to puppies 6-12 months who have not scored 100% in this class at a previous trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Open class. One minute to reach quarry, mark quarry for 30 seconds, may leave and reenter multiple times.

33. Vertically challenged – Basset Hounds, Dachshunds, Glen of Imaal etc.

34. Veterans – 6 – 10 years

35. Super Seniors Over 10 years

36. Larger dogs over 16"

Division 7. BWTA Racing – All racing is pre-entry only!

Open to all terrier types and dachshunds. All terriers must be muzzled to compete, exhibitor must provide own muzzle. Plastic basket muzzles or Softie muzzles may be used only. The entry desk may have some muzzles for sale. Fighters will be disqualified, no exceptions! The judge's decision is final!!

3. Novice Adult GTG – Over 1 year of age

Open to dogs over 1 year who have not scored 100% in this class at a previous trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Adult Open class. One minute to reach quarry, mark quarry for 30 seconds, may leave and reenter multiple times.

4. Open Puppy GTG – 6 – 12 months of age

Open to puppies 6-12 months who have not scored 100% in this class at a previous trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship class. Thirty seconds to reach quarry, mark quarry for one minute, may leave and reenter once.

5. Open Adult GTG – Over 1 year of age

Open to Dogs over one year who have not scored 100% in this class at a previous trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Adult Championship class. Thirty seconds to reach quarry, mark quarry for one minute, may leave and reenter once.

6. Puppy Championship GTG – 6 – 12 months of age

Open to puppies 6 – 12 months of age that have scored 100% in an Open GTG class at this or any other trial, or previously has competed in a Championship class. 30 seconds to reach quarry, mark quarry for one minute, may leave and reenter once.

7. Adult Championship GTG 12.5" and under – over 1 year of age

Open to Adult dogs over one year that have scored 100% in an Open GTG class at this or any other trial, or previously have competed in a Championship class. 30 seconds to reach quarry, mark quarry for one minute, may leave and reenter once.

8. Adult Championship GTG over 12.5" – over 1 year of age

Open to Adult dogs over one year that have scored 100% in an Open GTG class at this or any other trial, or previously have competed in a Championship class. 30 seconds to reach quarry, mark quarry for one minute, may leave and reenter once.

9. Veterans Championship GTG – over six years of age

Open to Adult dogs over six year who have scored 100% in an Open GTG class at this or any other trial, or previously have competed in a Championship class. 30 seconds to reach quarry, mark quarry for one minute, may leave and reenter once.

10. Super Senior GTG – over 10 years of age

Open to Adult dogs over ten years of age with any experience level. 30 seconds to reach quarry, mark quarry for one minute, may leave and reenter until target time is reached.

Division 2. BWTA Super Go To Ground

For any earth working terrier or dachshund type, an extra long puzzle earth with false exit and turns designed to test your dogs brains as well as his speed in the tunnel. Ch and Reserve for fastest times of the day!

11. Dog or bitch 12.5" and under Super GTG

12. Dog or bitch over 12.5" Super GTG

Division 3. BWTA Barn Hunt – open to all breeds!

Special vented PVC rat tubes are hidden in different above ground "stalls" in the barn. There is one rat in only one of the tubes, this event tests your dog's scenting, tracking ability and prey drive and also tests your ability to read your dog. The dog is timed from when you release him until when you tell the judge he has found the correct tube with the rat. This is a great event for the kids and their special dog. Ch and Reserve for fastest times of the day!

Division 4. BWTA Obedience

All terrier, dachshund and lurcher types may compete in Obedience.

Competition will be in the entry building at lunchtime. This is a very forgiving competition, and meant to be fun for you and your dog! Ch and Reserve for highest score (fewest mistakes) of the day!

20. Sub Novice – for the true beginner, all exercises are done on lead, sit, heel, sit stay and down stay, recall, stand for exam. If your dog does off lead work reliably this is not the class for you. If you took a puppy class years ago and want to see what he remembers this is it!

21. Novice – Some off lead work with the same exercises as in Sub Novice.

Division 5. BWTA Agility

Competitors must be under 16" and a terrier or dachshund or mix thereof. Other breeds may run the course for exhibition only with the consent of the judge and if time allows. Courses will be posted at the entry desk. Don't
