Overly aggressive dogs, or the owners failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the judges or the trial chairperson.

- All racing terriers must be muzzled to race.
- No refunds/substitutions except for bitches in season.
- Bitches in season not allowed on trial grounds.
- No loose dogs on the trial grounds.
- No puppies under 3 months allowed on the grounds.
- No puppies for sale on trial grounds.
- We reserve the right to deny any entry for any reason, entry fees will be refunded.

### From I71 or I65:

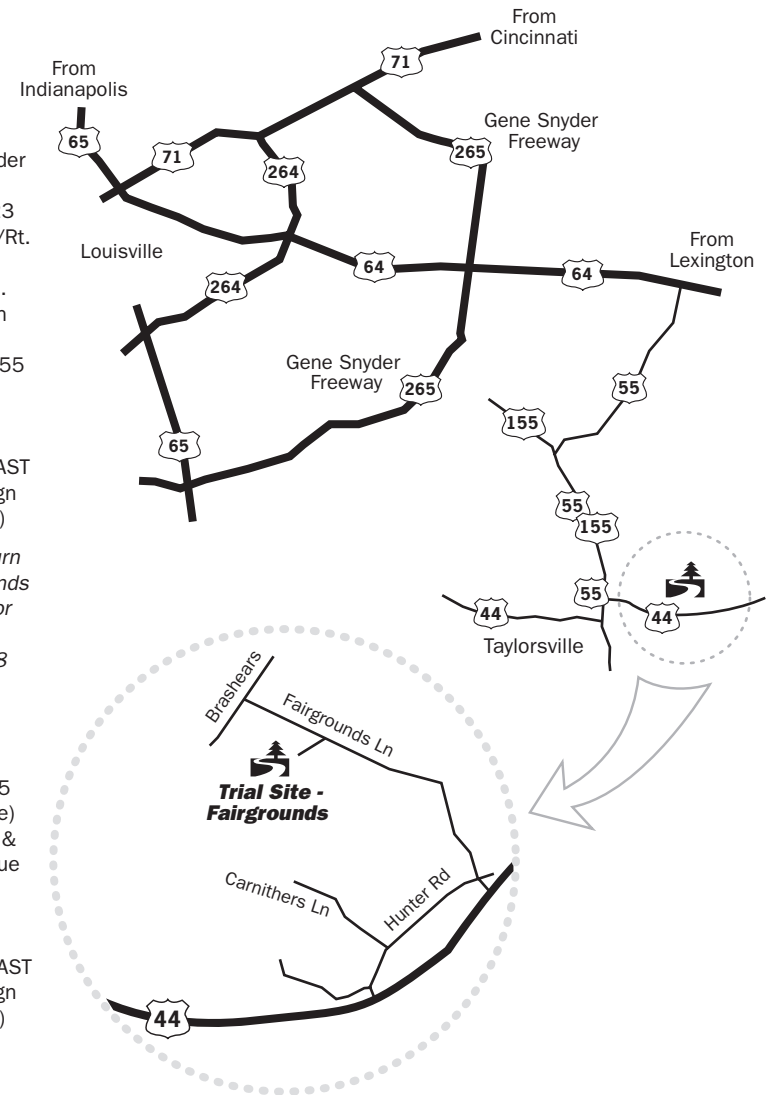
Take the Gene Snyder Freeway (I-265) to Exit 23: Take Exit 23 (J'town/Taylorsville/Rt. 155) & go EAST towards Taylorsville. Go 1.6 miles & turn RIGHT at stoplight, continuing on Rt. 155 SOUTH/55 SOUTH. Go 13.2 miles into Taylorsville, & turn LEFT onto Rt. 44 EAST (stoplight/green sign for the Fairgrounds)

**\*\* Go 3 miles & turn LEFT onto Fairgrounds Road (green sign for Fairgrounds). The Fairgrounds are 0.8 miles on the LEFT.**

### DIVISION 1. B. A SANCTIONED RACING

Racing is PRE-ENTRY only except for the Novice Terrier classes.

- For all terrier types & Dachshunds. All terriers must be muzzled to compete, exhibitors must provide own muzzle. Plastic basket muzzles or softie muzzles only. The entry desk will offer appropriate muzzles for sale. Fighters will be disqualified.
- Judges decision is final!
- A dog that places first in its class and competes in flat and hurdle races is eligible for the championship race.

#### Flats

- Class 1: Dog or Bitch Pups, up to 12.5"
- Class 2: Dog or Bitch Pups, over 12.5"
- Class 3: Shorties Under 10"
- Class 4: Super Seniors Over 10 yrs. old
- Class 5: Novice Terriers (never won a race)
- Class 6: Adult Dogs 12.5"& Under
- Class 7: Adult Dogs Over 12 1.2"
- Class 8: Adult Bitches 12.5"& Under
- Class 9: Adult Bitches Over 12.5"
- Class 10: Veterans 6 - 10 yrs. 12.5" & Under
- Class 11: Veterans 6 - 10 yrs. Over 12.5"
- Class 12: Dachshunds (no muzzle needed)

#### Hurdles

- (Over low hurdles – up to 8")
- Class 13: Dachshunds
- Dachshunds Championship Race
- Class 14: Dog or Bitch Pups, up to 12.5"
- Class 15: Dog or Bitch Pups, over 12.5"
- Class 16: Shorties Under 10"
- Class 17: Super Seniors Over 10 yrs. old
- Class 18: Novice Terriers (never won a race)
- Under Puppies, Over Puppies, Shorties, Super Seniors, & Novice Championship Races

- (Over higher hurdles – over 8")
- Class 19: Adult Dogs 12.5"& under
- Class 20: Adult Dogs Over 12.5"

## DIVISION 2. BWTA SANCTIONED GO-TO-GROUND

For any earthworking terrier type or dachshund. BWTA time limits and other rules apply for each division. Both puppies and adults may COMPLETELY progress from Novice to Championship at this trial.

Rules for BWTA Go-To-Ground are to follow. Please familiarize yourself with them as they may vary slightly from other earthdog club rules.

### GO-TO-GROUND RULES

1. Schooling prior to this competition IS permitted during practice hours ONLY. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from go-to-ground competition at this trial. No fee refunds.
2. Exhibitors are expected to pick up score sheets for their dogs at the Secretary's stand and, at the time of the competition, to take such score sheets to the Den Steward for scoring by the Judge.
3. Exhibitors are encouraged to read the score sheets carefully as they contain important information regarding the requirements, specifications and judging of each class.
4. A line approximately two feet from the entrance hole will be designated as the starting line. Time starts when dog is released. The dog is to be released so that all four of the dogs feet are on the ground before crossing the starting line. Any violation of this rule, accidental or intentional shall result in disqualification of dog from class in which the violation occurred. No fee refunds.
5. After the dog is released the handler shall remain next to the entrance hole. Commands and encouragement may be given. The judge will signal when the dog has completed working.
6. Dogs which have previously scored 100% in the Novice or Open Class at any trial MAY NOT under any circumstances, compete in these same classes at this trial.
8. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to collect the score sheet after the judging is complete.
9. The Den Steward may, upon observing a rule violation, disqualify an entry. Judges decisions are final!

Class 25: Pre-Novice Puppy GTG — 4 up to 6 months

Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. (One minute to reach quarry; mark quarry for 15 seconds; may leave the earth & re-enter multiple times.)

Class 26: Novice Puppy GTG — 6 up to 12 months

Open to terriers 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave the earth & re-enter several times; work quarry for 30 seconds.)

Class 27: Novice Adult GTG

Open to terriers one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth & re-enter several times; work quarry for 30 seconds.)

## DIVISION 6: OPEN FIELD LURE COURSING

Open to all breeds, all ages

Class 51: Puppies 4 to 12 months

Class 52: Adults 1 year and over — Under 12.5"

Class 53: Adults 1 year and over — 12.5 - 15"

Class 54: Larger Dogs Over 15"

Class 55: Shorties (Under 10" terriers)

Class 56: Vertically challenged breeds  
(i.e. Dachshunds, Basset Hounds; no Shortie terriers)

Class 57: Veterans — 6 - 10 years of age

Class 58: Super Seniors — Over 10 years of age

## **DIVISION 4. BARN HUNT SANCIONED AGILITY**

*Competitors must be under 16" & a terrier or dachshund or mix.*

*Any class with entries over 12 dogs will be split into 3 divisions:  
Under 10", 10 - 12.5" and over 12.5" - 16"*

*Classes 44, 45, 46, 47 and 48:  
open to both on & off lead competitors with a 5 second penalty for running on lead.*

Class 40: Beginner — On Lead  
*Must have passed 3 or fewer classes at any trial, true beginners only.*

Class 41: Advanced — On Lead  
*For those comfortable with obstacles but NOT working off lead yet*

Class 42: Beginner — Off Lead  
*For the true first timer just starting off lead work, teeter/weaves optional*

Class 43: Advanced — Off Lead  
*May NOT cross enter into Advanced or Beginner On Lead*

Class 44: Advanced Veteran — On/Off Lead  
*6 yrs. and older*

Class 45: Gambler's Choice  
*Points assigned to obstacles. May end in Gamble.*

Class 46: Jumpers  
*Consisting of jumps & may include tire and tunnels.*

Class 47: Tunnelers  
*Series of tunnels in a pattern.*

Class 48: Youth Handler  
*Handler must be under 16 years of age.*

## **DIVISION 5. BARN HUNT SANCIONED OBEDIENCE**

*All terriers, dachshunds & lurchers may compete in Obedience. One competitive class per dog please, additional classes may be entered for exhibition or schooling only, inform the judge*

Class 49: Sub-Novice  
*for the true beginner, all exercises are done On Lead: heeling, sit stay, down stay, recall, stand for exam, if your dog can work off lead at all this is not the class for you.*

Class 50: Novice  
*Some Off Lead work with exercises as in Sub Novice*

Class 28: Open Puppy GTG — 6 up to 12 months  
Open to terriers 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice GTG class at this or a previous trial. Not open to any terrier that has previously achieved 100% in this class. Puppy entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may enter the Puppy Championship class at this trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once & re-enter; work quarry one minute.)

Class 29: Open Adult  
Open to terriers one year of age or older which have scored 100% in a Novice GTG class at this or a previous trial. Not open to any terrier that has previously achieved 100% in this class, including puppies. Adults achieving 100% in Open may advance to Championship Certificate at this trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once & re-enter; work quarry one minute.)

Class 30: Puppy Champion  
Open to terriers 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open GTG class at this or a previous trial. First and second place winners will be Puppy GTG Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter; work quarry for one minute.)

Championship Certificate - The following 4 classes are subject to the following:  
Open to any adult terrier 1 year and over, which has previously achieved a 100% score in the Open Class at this or a previous trial. Upon reaching 1 year of age, puppies having passed the Open Puppy Class or have been competing in the Puppy Championship are automatically eligible. First & Second place winners will be GTG Champion & Reserve in each height division.

Class 31: Adult Champion — 12.5" and under

Class 32: Adult Champion — over 12.5"

Class 33: Veteran Champion — 6 - 10 years of age

Class 34: Super Senior — Over 10 years of age

## **DIVISION 3. BARN HUNT**

- OPEN TO ALL BREEDS
- Specially designed PVC rat tubes in different above ground locations, one rat in only one of the tubes...this event tests your dogs scenting, tracking ability and prey drive and tests your ability to "read" your dog. The dog is timed from when you release him until you tell the judge he has found the correct tube with the rats.

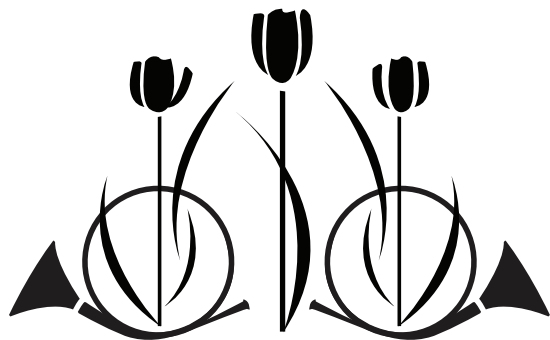

**The Bluegrass Working Terrier Association is honored to sponsor this class, and very proud to promote the versatility of the working terrier breeds and dachshunds.** This award will go to the dog with the highest score in one of each performance class from divisions 1-6; *you may enter as many classes in each performance division as you like but only the single highest placement you receive in each division will count towards the versatility award, so the more classes you enter the better chance you will have! Versatility placements in each class will be done separately and in addition to the regular class placements (i.e. your versatility dog may be fourth in the class overall but have the first place score of the versatility entries in the class).* The points are kept as follows: **1st = 15 points; 2nd = 10 points; 3rd = 9 points; 4th = 8 points; 5th = 7 points; 6th = 6 points.** In the event of a tie a tie-breaker will be necessary. The tie-breaker will be determined by the trial chairperson. The High Point Versatility Award is pre-entry only and is an extra one time \$5 fee per dog.
